

Tigres UANL (MEX) vs. Alajuelense (CRC)

Group A, October 3rd 2024, Estadio Universitario, San Nicolás de los Garza.

They will face each other for the first time in an international club tournament.



TIGRES UANL (MEX)

Tigres UANL has achieved two victories in Group A: 4-0 against CF Monterrey and 7-1 against Frazsiers.

The University team will play their second home match; in their first, they won 4-0 against Monterrey in the Clásico Regio.

Tigres UANL scored 11 goals in their 2 matches and made 49 shots (22 on target, 3 hit the posts, and 13 were off target). Additionally, they kept a clean sheet and limited their rivals to only 10 shots.

Standout players:

Ana Dias (POR). The player born in Portugal scored 1 goal and provided 2 assists (vs. Frazsiers). Along with her teammate Jennifer Hermoso, they were the players who made the most shots against Frazsiers Whip.

Stephany Mayor (MEX). The forward scored a brace against Frazsiers Whip and provided 2 assists against Monterrey. She has made 4 shots in 121 minutes on the pitch.

Alison González (MEX). She was one of the standout players on the team in the 7-1 victory against Frazsiers Whip in week 3 of Group A, scoring 1 penalty goal, providing 1 assist, and making 4 shots. At the youth level, she played 5 matches in the Concacaf U-17 Championship in Nicaragua 2018 where she scored five goals and at the U-20 level, she scored six goals in six games in the Dominican Republic 2020.



LD Alajuelense defeated Frazsiers Whip 5-0 in Week 1 and lost 4-0 to Gotham in Week 2, both at Alejandro Morera Soto Stadium, Alajuela.

The five goals scored to date were all achieved in the second half, all from open play, with 34 shots of which 10 were on target, two hit the posts, and 17 were off target.

Standout players:

Ángela Mesén (CRC). Scored a brace in the 5-0 win against Frazsiers Whip. The 21-year-old forward has made 3 shots in her 2 appearances and completed 86% of her passes.

Stephannie Blanco (CRC). Leads the team in passes (85), shots (5), and recovered balls (4). The footballer from Talamanca played in the W Gold Cup 2024 and at the U-20 level in the Concacaf Championship in Trinidad and Tobago 2018.

Katheryn Arroyo (PAN). Was on the pitch for 87 minutes across 2 appearances in the Concacaf W 2024, where she made 3 shots. She has the best passing percentage (93%) in the CWCC 2024-25.
