



2024 CONCACAF W Gold Cup

USA vs. Mexico / Group A

Dignity Health Sports Park, Carson, CA

All-Time series:

It will be the 43rd match in history. The United States has 40 victories, Mexico achieved 1 win, and they drew once.

The United States has 16 consecutive victories against Mexico, including the Concacaf W, Concacaf Women's Olympic Qualifiers, and International Friendlies.

They last faced each other in Group A in the 2022 Concacaf W, with the USA winning 1-0 (Kristen Mewis) at the Estadio Universitario de San Nicolás de los Garza (July 11, 2022).

In encounters between these teams, Mexico defeated the United States 2-1 (Maribel Domínguez and Verónica Pérez; Carli Lloyd) in the semifinals of the 2010 Concacaf W, qualifiers for the FIFA Women's World Cup Germany 2011, at the Beto Ávila Baseball Stadium, Cancun (November 5, 2010). Prior to that, at the Pan American Games in Brazil 2007, Mexico beat the United States 2-1, who were represented by the Under-20 team.

They were rivals in Haiti 1991, Canada 1994, Canada/United States 2002, United States 2006, Mexico 2010, United States 2014, 2018, and Mexico 2022.

United States (USA)

Results in the 2022 W Gold Cup (5-0 against the Dominican Republic and 4-0 against Argentina).

They had a passing accuracy of 92% in the last match against Argentina. They have a total of 1016 passes in two Group A matches.

They have won their last 5 matches across all competitions (including the 2024 W Gold Cup, 2023 Pan American Games in Chile, and International Friendlies).

Their last defeat was in the 2023 Pan American Games in Chile against the host country, losing 2-1 (Karen Araya and Yanara Aedo; Emeri Adames) in the semifinals (October 31, 2023).

They have kept a clean sheet in 20 of their last 25 matches (80% efficiency). They conceded only 1 goal in their last 5 games: Shen Mengyu from China in an International Friendly held on December 5, 2023, at Toyota Stadium in Frisco.

Players to watch:

Jaedyn Shaw. Scored a brace in the recent 4-0 victory against Argentina. Has 3 shots in the 2024 W Gold Cup. The forward has scored 4 goals in her 6 appearances with the US team.

Alex Morgan. Has scored goals in the 2 victories of the United States (against the Dominican Republic and Argentina). Has scored 9 goals when facing Mexico (7 in friendlies and 2 in the 2018 Concacaf W).

Lindsey Horan. Alongside her teammate Trinity Rodman, had the most shots with 6 against Argentina. Provided an assist in Jaedyn Shaw's first goal against Argentina.

Naomi Girma. Was the player with the most passes with (97) against Argentina. The San Diego Wave FC player has 27 appearances with the USA.



Mexico (MEX)

Mexico's results in the 2024 W Gold Cup (0-0 against the United States and 8-0 against the Dominican Republic).

They have won 10 of their last 11 matches in regular time across all competitions they have



played in.

They have kept a clean sheet in their last 6 recent matches, including matches in the W Gold Cup, 2023 Pan American Games in Chile, and 2024 RTWGC.

They haven't lost a match since September 2, 2022, when they fell to New Zealand in an International Friendly (0-1) at Dignity Health Sports Park in Carson.

Players to watch:

Kiana Palacios. Had (8) shots in the 8-0 victory against the Dominican Republic; two of those shots hit the posts.

Jacqueline Ovalle. Scored (2) goals and provided (2) assists, with 5 shots, two ball recoveries, and 58 passes in the win against the Dominican Republic.

Alexia Delgado. Provided an assist and completed (72) total passes with a 92% success rate against the Dominican Republic.

Rebeca Bernal. Is the Mexican player with the most successful passes (92) in the 2024 W Gold Cup. The team captain scored a header goal and had two shots against the Dominican Republic.
