

#93 Panamá vs. Costa Rica

Estadio Rommel Fernández, Panama City, PAN

They will face each other for the sixth time in the CNL. Panama leads the series in League A of 2022/23 and the quarterfinals of 2023/24 and 2024/25. Panama defeated Costa Rica 1-0 in the first leg of the quarterfinals.

Players to watch:

José Fajardo. He scored 6 goals in his last 9 matches (including friendlies, Concacaf World Cup Qualifiers, Copa América, and Concacaf Nations League). He scored in 4 of the last 5 matches against Costa Rica in the CNL.

Édgar Bárcenas. Alongside his teammate José Rodríguez, he made three shots in the first leg of the quarterfinals. The captain is the player with the most goal contributions for the Panamanians (4 goals and 3 assists) in the CNL.

César Blackman. He was the player with the most fouls against him (5) in the first leg of the quarterfinals against Costa Rica. The left-back made 1 shot, 1 ball recovery, and delivered 32 passes.

Players to watch:

Francisco Calvo. He is the top scorer for the national team in the CNL (7). The captain scored goals in all 4 editions (3 in 2019/20, 1 in 2022/23, 1 in 2023/24, and 2 in 2024/25). He has made 5 shots and 187 passes in the current edition.

Warren Madrigal. He leads Costa Rica in shots (9). In the 0-1 defeat against Panama, he made 2 shots. He scored goals in both victories for the Ticos in Group A of the current edition (3-0 vs. Guadeloupe and Guatemala).

Manfred Ugalde. He is the leader in assists for Costa Rica in the current edition (2). He played in all 5 matches and has drawn 7 fouls. The forward has made 8 appearances over the last 2 editions.
