## FACTS

They drew 1-1 in the first leg. Roger Martínez pk for Club América and Felipe Mora pk at Providence Park, Portland, Oregon, USA (Apr 28, 2021).



### CLUB AMÉRICA

6th appearance in the Scotiabank Concacaf Champions League (2013/14, 2014/15, 2015/16, 2018, 2020 and 2021).

**Titles since 1962 (7): 1977, 1987, 1990, 1992, 2006, 2014/15 and 2015/16.**

Club América ranks sixth among the teams with the most goals scored since 1962, Deportivo Saprissa is at the top with 273 goals scored and Cruz Azul with 244.

**SCCL record: G-38 W-21 D-10 L-7 (GF-82 GA-33).**

**Head Coach: Santiago Solari (ARG)**, 44 years old. The Argentine made his debut as a coach at Real Madrid Castilla. He then was in the first team of Real Madrid of Spain with whom he was consecrated in the FIFA Club World Cup 2018. SCCL record: GP-3 W-1 D-1 L-1

**Top scorers in SCCL:** Oribe Peralta (MEX) with 10, Darío Benedetto (ARG) with 8, Carlos Darwin Quintero (COL) and Michael Arroyo (ECU) with 6 each.

Players with the most appearances in SCCL: Paul Aguilar (MEX) with 23 appearances, Osvaldo Martínez (PAR) with 20 PJ and Rubens Sambueza (ARG) with 19 PJ.

Top scorers in SCCL Quarterfinals: Oribe Peralta (MEX) with 5 and Henry Martín (MEX) with 4.

Scorers in SCCL 2021: Roger Martínez (COL), Federico Viñas (URU) and Sergio Díaz (PAR) with 1.

Assists in SCCL 2021: Mauro Laínez (MEX) and Álvaro Fidalgo (MEX) with 1.

Saves in SCCL 2021: Guillermo Ochoa (MEX) with 9.

**SCCL KO stage Record: G-26 W-13 D-8 L-5.**

The only five losses in a knockout stage were: 3-0 vs. Herediano (Esteban Ramírez, Yendrick Ruiz and Jonathan Hansen), in SF 2014/15, 3-1 vs. Toronto (Sebastian Giovinco, Jozy Altidore and Ashtone Morgan; Andrés Ibargüen), at SF 2018; 1-0 vs. Atlanta (Jackson Conway), in QF 2020; 3-1 vs. Los Ángeles FC (Carlos Vela x2 and Latif Blessing; Sebastián Cáreres), at SF 2020; and 0-1 vs. Olimpia (Jerry Bengtson), in R16 2021.

**Home record in SCCL: G-18 W-12 D-4 L-2 (GF-41 GA-9).**

The only home losses in the SCCL were vs. Central American rivals:

0-1 vs. Alajuelense (Jerry Nelson Palacios) Group 4 (22 Oct 2013).

0-1 vs. Olimpia (Jerry Bengtson) second leg Round of 16 (Apr 14, 2021).

Won the only penalty shootout in SCCL (5-3) vs. Comunicaciones (GUA) in the Round of 16 in 2020, after a 2-2 tie on the aggregate scoreboard.

**Club América has played 31 home and away series since 1962):**

- Managed to advance 27 times, in 4 he was eliminated (by 2 Central American clubs, 1 from MLS, 1 from Liga MX).

- 23 second leg at home (15W 5E 3L)

- 8 games second leg away (3W 1D, 4L)

- 8 second leg at home (6W 2D, 0L)

- 23 first leg away (9W 9D 5L)

- Made progress in all six quarter-final series.

Register 1 definition in Overtime in SCCL:

Club América 1-0 Santos Laguna (Semifinals). After a scoreless draw in regulation time, Club América's Michael Arroyo scored a goal in the 102nd minute of extra time, at the Azteca Stadium (Apr 5, 2016).

#### **TOP PLAYERS:**

**Roger Martínez (COL)** scored Club América penalty goal in the first leg against Portland Timbers. In turn, the Colombian forward led the shooting category at Providence Park (3).

**Bruno Valdez (PAR)** was the player with the most balls recovered in the first leg of the Quarterfinals (3). The Paraguayan defender had 1 shot, 3 punts, 24 passes and 2 infractions against the Portland Timbers.



## **PORTLAND TIMBERS**

3rd appearance in the SCCL (2014/15, 2016/17 and 2021).

**SCCL record: G-11 W-6 D-3 L-2 (GF-30 GA-16).**

**Head Coach: Giovanni Savarese (VEN)**, 49 years old: his beginnings as a coach in New York Cosmos (2013-2017) with whom he obtained the NASL Championship (2013, 2015 and 2016). Since his arrival at Portland Timbers he has achieved the MLS is Back Tournament in 2020 and the MLS runner-up in 2018. SCCL record: G-3 W-1 D-2 L-0.

Top scorers in SCCL: Fanendo Adi (NIG) with 4 goals, Yimmi Chará (COL), Maximiliano Urruti (ARG) and Diego Valeri (ARG) with 3 goals.

Players with the most appearances in SCCL: Fanendo Adi (NIG), Diego Chará (COL) and Diego Valeri (ARG) with 7, Jake Gleeson (NZL) with 6 games.

Top scorer in SCCL Quarterfinals: Felipe Mora (CHI) with 1.

Top scorers in SCCL 2021: Yimmi Chará (COL) with 3, Felipe Mora (CHI) with 2, Diego Valeri (ARG) and Marvin Loría (CRC) with 1.

Assists in SCCL 2021: Josecarlos Van Rankin (MEX) with 2, Diego Valeri (ARG), Cristhian Paredes (PAR) and Dairon Asprilla (COL) with 1.

Saves in SCCL 2021: (11). Steven Clark (USA) with 7 and Jeffrey Attinella (USA) with 5

Portland Timbers have scored goals in every game in the SCCL.

#### **TOP PLAYERS:**

**Diego Valeri (ARG)** had 26 passes, a shot, 4 balls recovered in the first leg. Among with Diego Chará (COL) they will become the players with the highest appearances in the history of the club in SCCL (with 8 games).

**Felipe Mora (CHI)** scored the penalty which tied the match in the first leg vs. America club. The Chilean forward scored the latest goal in the current SCCL at 96 minutes of play.
