

Orlando City SC (USA) vs. Cavalry FC (CAN)

Inter and Co Stadium, Orlando, USA

Orlando City won the first match 0-3 goals by (Duncan McGuire and Facundo Torres x2), Starlight Stadium, Langford (22-FEB-2024).



Orlando City (USA)

Orlando City SC (USA) maintained their unbeaten record in the CCC (1W-2D) and for the first time scored three goals in the CCC. For the second three-game, Orlando City didn't concede any goals and achieved their first away victory.

It's only the 5th occasion that an MLS club has won by a score of 0-3 (away) in the history of the CCC, previously achieved by Los Angeles Galaxy in 2013-2014 against Cartaginés (CRC), Philadelphia Union in 2021 against Atlanta United (USA), Los Angeles FC in 2023 against LD Alajuelense (CRC), and Whitecaps (CAN).

No MLS team that won away in the first leg of a knockout tie by a score of 0-3 has been eliminated, all have advanced. Philadelphia Union and Los Angeles FC are the only ones with similar results.

Orlando City managed to draw in their only home game in the CCC: 1-1 vs. Tigres UANL (Ercan Kara; Sebastián Córdova) in the round of 16 of 2023. In that match, goalkeeper Pedro Gallese made 8 saves and 7 clearances.

Orlando City has not lost in regular time in the CCC (0-0 and 1-1 vs. Tigres UANL in Round of 16 in 2023 and 0-3 vs. Cavalry in Round One of 2024). They kept a clean sheet in 2 out of 3 CCC matches (0-0 vs. Tigres UANL in 2023 and 0-3 vs. Cavalry in 2024), conceding goals in the 1-1 draw vs. Tigres UANL in 2023.

They lost 1 match out of the last 14 at home in the MLS. During that period, they secured 9 wins, 4 draws, and 1 loss. Their last home loss was in extra time in the Conference Semifinals - MLS Cup 2023.

How the goals were scored: Open play (2), header (1).

Players to watch:

Facundo Torres (URU). Made (4) shots (4) against Cavalry (scored 2 goals). Has played every match in the CCC editions 2023 and 2024. Scored his first two goals in the CCC.

Nicolás Lodeiro (URU). Debuted as an Orlando City player in the CCC. The Uruguayan had previously played for Seattle Sounders winning the title in 2022. The forward has scored 7 goals and provided 4 assists in 10 appearances in the CCC.

Duncan McGuire (USA). Scored the opening goal in the 3-0 victory against Cavalry. The 23-year-old American forward made his second appearance in the history of the CCC (2023 and 2024).



Cavalry FC (CAN)

Cavalry (CAN) suffered defeat #36 for Canadian clubs in the CCC. Canadian teams have now gone 4 home matches without a win in the CCC (3L-1D), marking the third consecutive loss for Canadian teams against opponents from the United States, the worst streak in CCC history.

For the fourth consecutive game, Canadian teams failed to score against opponents from the United States in the CCC, marking the worst streak.

Cavalry is the 5th Canadian club to lose at home against opponents from the United States. Previous clubs include Toronto Italia in 1976, Toronto FC in 2010-2011, 2011-2012 (twice),



and 2018, Montreal Impact in 2013-2014 and 2014-2015, and Whitecaps in 2015-2016, 2016-2017 (twice), and 2023.

Cavalry FC will seek to end an 8-game losing streak for Canadian teams on the road in the CCC. The last victory was FC Montreal against CD Olimpia from Honduras (0-1), at the Inter and Co Stadium, Orlando.

The last series between a Canadian team and a US team in CCC history ended in favor of the US team: Los Angeles FC eliminated Vancouver Whitecaps in the quarter-finals of 2023, winning both legs (0-3 and 3-0).

Coach Tommy Wheeldon Jr.'s Team (ENG) won 3 of Their last 5 away matches in the Canadian Premier League 2023. They only lost in extra time in the final against Forge FC (2-1) in Hamilton.

FC Montreal in the round of 16 in 2022 was the only Canadian team to score 3 goals in the second leg of a knockout series when they eliminated Santos Laguna from Liga MX.

Players to watch:

Myer Bevan (NZL). Made 50% of Cavalry's shots against Orlando City (2 out of 4), all on target. The New Zealander scored 11 goals in his 29 appearances in the 2023 Canadian Championship.

Jesse Daley (AUS). The midfielder made 5 ball recoveries. He only missed one of his 25 passes against Orlando City.

Eryk Kobza (CAN). The 22-year-old midfielder was the player with the most passes (47) against Orlando City.
