



Tigres UANL (MEX) vs. Orlando City SC (USA)

Wednesday March 13, 2024, Stadium Universitario, San Nicolas de los Garza (MEX)

Tigres UANL and Orlando City drew 0-0 in the first match on March 5, 2024, in Orlando, and will face each other for the fourth time in history, all in the Round of 16 in 2023 and 2024.

In 2023, they drew (0-0 and 1-1), with Tigres UANL winning the series on the away goals rule.

Tigres UANL 0-0 Orlando City, Estadio Universitario de San Nicolás de los Garza (March 7, 2023).

Orlando City 1-1 Tigres UANL (Ercan Kara; Francisco Córdova), Inter&Co Stadium, Orlando (March 15, 2023).

Orlando City 0-0 Tigres UANL, Round of 16, Inter&Co Stadium, Orlando (March 5, 2024).

With the draw, Orlando City ended a streak of two consecutive wins, their best streak in the CCL.

Playing at home, it is the first time that Orlando City (USA) failed to score goals and secured their third draw against Liga MX rivals, all three against Tigres UANL 0-0 and 1-1 in 2023, and 0-0 in 2024.

The 0-0 draw on March 5, 2024, between Orlando and Tigres was the 96th draw and the 26th with a (0-0) scoreline between MLS and Liga MX teams.

Tigres UANL reached three consecutive matches without losing in the CCC (2 draws, 1 win). However, they only won one of their last three matches. For Tigres UANL, it was the sixth 0-0 draw in CCC history and the fifth in a first-leg match. In the previous four, they were only eliminated by CD FAS (SLV) in 1979, over 44 years ago. On that occasion, the Salvadoran club went on to win the title.

Tigres UANL drew for the fifth time in a first-leg match in the CCC (3 draws, 2 losses) in the Round of 16 but was never eliminated when they didn't win the first leg. The other draws were 2-2 against Herediano (CRC) in 2018, 0-0 against Orlando City in 2023, while they lost 1-0 against Saprissa (CRC) in 2019 and 2-1 against Alianza FC (SLV) in 2020.



Tigres UANL (MEX)

Tigres UANL eliminated CS Herediano in the Round of 16 in 2018, Deportivo Saprissa in 2019, Alianza FC from El Salvador in 2020, and Orlando City from the United States in 2023.

Tigres' only defeat against American rivals in the history of the Concacaf Champions Cup since the format change in 2008/09 was against Seattle Sounders 3-1 (DeAndre Yedlin, DjimiTraoré,



and Eddie Johnson; Elías Hernández for Tigres) in the second leg of the Quarterfinals (March 12, 2013).

Tigres won 9 of their last 14 matches in the Concacaf Champions Cup and lost only once (3-1) in the semifinals of 2023, which was later won by Club León.

Every time Tigres UANL drew with a 0-0 scoreline in the first-leg match, they scored goals in the second leg and advanced to the next round (against Querétaro in the Semifinals of 2015/16, against New York City in the Quarterfinals of 2020, and against Orlando City in the Round of 16 of 2023).

Players to watch:

André-Pierre Gignac (FRA). He is the player with the most shots on the team in the 2024 CCC with (7). Gignac has scored 17 goals and has 2 assists in 31 appearances in the CCC.

Rafael Carioca (BRA). He was the player with the most passes (96) in the first match against Orlando City. The Brazilian midfielder has 244 passes, 4 shots, and 4 ball recoveries in three matches in the 2024 CCC.

Nahuel Guzmán (ARG). He has not conceded goals in his last two matches against Vancouver Whitecaps and Orlando City SC) and has 3 saves. Guzmán, a champion with Tigres in 2020, has 41 appearances and 18 clean sheets throughout the CCC.



Orlando City (USA)

Orlando City has never lost a match in the Concacaf Champions League in regular time (2-W-3-D) between 2023 and 2024, and in the 2024 edition, it is undefeated with 2 wins and 1 draw, scoring 6 goals and conceding 1.

Orlando City has not conceded goals in the first half in 3 matches and achieved a 22% effectiveness in shots (6 goals after 27 attempts).

Out of its previous 5 games, it only managed to score goals in the first half in 1 match (3-0 vs. Cavalry in Round One 2024).

It kept a clean sheet in 60% of the matches in the history of the CCL (0-0 vs. Tigres UANL in 2023, 0-3 vs. Cavalry, and 0-0 vs. Tigres UANL in 2024). Furthermore, it never conceded goals while playing away: 0-0 vs. Tigres UANL (Round of 16 in 2023) and 3-0 vs. Cavalry (Round One 2024).

How the goals were scored: From open play (5), headers (1).

Players to watch:

Facundo Torres (URU). He had a passing accuracy of 94% in the first match against Tigres UANL. The Uruguayan has played 5 matches in two appearances in the CCL and has scored 2 goals, provided 1 assist, and had 4 shots on goal in the 2024 CCC.

Nicolás Lodeiro (URU). The forward has scored 8 goals and provided 5 assists in 12 appearances. He was a champion in 2022 as a player for Seattle Sounders. Lodeiro has scored one goal and provided one assist in the 2024 CCC.

César Araujo (URU). He had 4 ball recoveries, 2 clearances, and completed 34 passes (87% passing accuracy) in the first match against Tigres UANL.
