

## **Cuba vs USA Group A**

All-Time Series: 6 games

- 4 wins United States
- 2 draws
- 0 wins Cuba
- 8 goals United States
- 1 goal Cuba

The United States has a streak of 4 consecutive wins against Cuba in the CMU20C.

This will be the 4th historic encounter in the first phase of the tournament, with 2 draws and 1 win for the United States, which was on June 22, 2002, in Honduras, in Group E, a 3-0 win for the United States with goals from Quinn Sullivan (2', 8', 43'). The 2 draws between these two teams were scoreless, the first on August 21, 1974, in Canada, and the second on August 19, 1986, in Trinidad & Tobago.

Cuba only managed to score 1 goal in the entire series against the United States, which was in a 2-1 defeat on April 22, 1988, in Guatemala, with a goal by Carlos Torres (72'). Ben Crowley (70') and Clint Carnell (71') scored for the United States.

Cuba started the tournament in Group A with a draw against Costa Rica, while the United States defeated Jamaica 9-0 on Friday, July 19, with David Vázquez and Pedro Soma each scoring a brace. Here are the post-match statistics for both teams.



- **Nikolas Tsakiris** from the United States scored his 4th goal in the history of the CMU20 (2022 and 2024). Moreover, he did it at 3 different ages: 2 goals at 16 years and 360 days, 1 goal at 17 years and 14 days, and 1 goal at 19 years and 30 days.
- The United States achieved their 82nd victory in the history of the CMU20, placing them in 2nd place historically for the most wins in the tournament.
- The United States won a match with a 9-0 scoreline for the 2nd time in their history, something that hadn't happened for 47 years, 9 months, and 22 days since they defeated the Dominican Republic with the same score, with goals by Rick Davis (15', 38', 62', 71'), **Rick Kren** (34'), **Joe Morone** (35', 80'), and **Keith Beam** (?). In that edition (1976), the United States finished in 3rd place.
- This is the 4th time in the history of the tournament that the United States scored 9 goals in a single match: 9-0 against the Dominican Republic in 1976 and 1978, 9-1 against Cuba in 2015, and 9-0 against Jamaica in 2024.



- For the 4th time in the last 3 editions of the CMU20, two different players scored a brace in the same match while playing for the United States, with **David Vázquez** and **Pedro Soma** achieving this feat.
- The United States has an impressive streak of 21 consecutive matches without a loss in the history of the CMU20 (19W-2D), which is the 2nd best streak for a team in the tournament, only surpassed by Mexico's streak of 28 consecutive matches without a loss (24W-4D) between the 1964 and 1978 tournaments.
- This is the 6th consecutive match without conceding a goal for the United States in the history of the CMU20, a similar streak last occurred with 6 games between the 2007 and 2009 editions.
- This is the 3rd consecutive victory in "debut" matches for the United States in the history of the tournament. In fact, in these 3 matches, they scored 26 goals and conceded only 1. Additionally, it is the 2nd time in a "debut" match that they scored 9 or more goals, having done so in 2022 against Saint Kitts and Nevis (10-0).

## Players to watch:

- **David Vazquez**. Scored the first goal and participated in 4 of the 9 goals against Jamaica, scoring a double and providing 2 assists.
- **Rubén Ramos**. Scored 1 goal and was the player with the most shots (4) in the victory against Jamaica in the first match of Group A.



- **Samuel Rodríguez** from Cuba scored his first goal in the tournament for his team and the 5th goal against Costa Rica in the history of the CMU20.
- This is the 13th draw for Cuba in 63 matches played in the history of the CMU20, and the 4th draw with a 1-1 scoreline.



- Cuba remains unbeaten in "debut" matches (2W-1D), but with this draw, they ended a streak of 2 consecutive victories.
- Cuba reached their 3rd consecutive match without a win against Central American teams in the CMU20 (2L-1D), but thanks to the draw, they broke a streak of 2 losses. However, they have only won 1 of their last 7 encounters against a Central American opponent (1W-5L-1D).
