

Alajuelense (CRC) vs. Comunicaciones (GUA)

Group B Alejandro Morera Soto, Alajuela, August 27, 2024

Alajuelense, the defending champion of the Central American Cup and leader of Group B with 9 points, will face Comunicaciones for the first time in the Central American Cup.

In the history of Concacaf club tournaments, these two teams have faced each other 16 times, with Alajuelense winning 11, drawing 2, and losing three.

The last time they met was in the quadrangular of the 2002 Interclub Cup on December 18, a 5-0 victory for Alajuelense with a brace from Érick Scott, Luis "yiyo" Marín, and a brace from Vicente Rosella.

The last victory for Comunicaciones against Alajuelense was 2-1 in the first leg of the First Round of the 1993 Concacaf Champions Cup on June 23, 1993, with a brace from Roderico Méndez. Alajuelense won the series with a total score of 5-2 after winning 4-0 in the second leg.

LD Alajuelense has faced Guatemalan clubs in official matches 46 times, winning 25, drawing 11, and losing 10. On the other hand, Comunicaciones has played 68 official matches against Costa Rican clubs, recording 18 wins, 16 draws, and 34 losses.

LD Alajuelense is undefeated in the CCAC over 13 matches (W-10 D-3) with 1 title (2023). It is the only club that has scored in every match and has the highest goal count with (33).

The defending champion won all 7 group stage matches (4 in 2023 and 3 in 2024), scoring 9 goals and conceding 5.

LDA had the most points (24), goals (24), wins (7), and passes (4155) in the CCAC 2023, achieving a perfect record in the group stage.

Best result in the CCAC: Champion in 2023.

Players to watch:

Diego Campos (CRC). He is the team's top scorer with 5 goals scored against Marathón, Luis Ángel Firpo, and a brace vs. Alianza FC. He made 9 shots in the previous 3 matches.

Anderson Cardoso (BRA). The Brazilian scored a goal (vs. Marathón) and 2 assists in addition to 7 shots and 5 fouls against him.

Celso Borges (CRC). He is the only player on LDA's roster who has played in all 13 matches in the two editions of the CCAC and is the leader in passes with (167) and ball recoveries with (6).



Comunicaciones FC (GUA)

Comunicaciones FC is unbeaten in 3 matches in the CCAC 2024 and has achieved two consecutive victories: 1-0 vs. Alianza FC and 2-1 vs. Marathón, at the Cementos Progreso Stadium, Guatemala City.

Comunicaciones FC has not lost in their last 5 matches in the CCAC (W-2 D-3) and has drawn their last two away games: 1-1 vs. Cartaginés in the 2023 Play-In and 1-1 vs. LA Firpo, in Group B in 2024.

Comunicaciones has not won in their last 3 away matches (D-2 L-1) and has never beaten Costa Rican opponents after 5 encounters (D-3 L-2), facing CS Herediano three times and CS Cartaginés twice in 2023.

Best result in the CCAC: Quarterfinals in 2023.

Players to watch:

Diego Casas (URU). The Uruguayan forward scored 1 goal (vs. Marathón) and was the player with the most shots (9) in the previous Group B matches.

Azarías Londoño (PAN). Has scored one goal (vs Marathon) and provided an assist against Luis Ángel Firpo. The Panamanian has played three matches, made 5 shots in 258 minutes on the field.

José Corena (COL). Leads the team in passes (105) and ball recoveries (8). Has played in all 11 matches, scoring 3 goals and providing 1 assist.
