

Mexico vs. Haiti - Group C

Mexico and Haiti will face each other for the fifth time in the group stage of the CMU20C, with the last two encounters ending in a draw. The first was 1-1 on January 22, 2015, in Jamaica, in Group B, with goals from Nerlin Saint-Vil (39') for Haiti and Mauro Laínez (53') for Mexico, and the second draw was 0-0 on June 23, 2022, in Group F in Honduras.

The footballer Nerlin Saint-Vil is the only Haitian national to have scored against Mexico in a CMU20C. Haiti has not scored any goals against Mexico in 4 matches.



The tournament hosts will have their 28th participation, having dominated the early years of the tournament from 1962 to 2015, a period in which they won thirteen titles. Mexico also has three runner-up finishes.

The top scorer for Mexico in the CMU20 is José Juan Macías with 10 goals. In 16 appearances in the FIFA U-20 Men's World Cup, Mexico is the most decorated Concacaf country, having achieved runner-up status in Tunisia in 1997 and third place in Colombia in 2011.

Mexico heads Group C where its rivals will be Panama, Guatemala, and Haiti.

Last appearance in the final round: Honduras 2022 (quarterfinals).

Record in the CMU20C: GP-135, W-98, D-24, L-13 (GF-370, GA-78).

Best results in the CMU20C: Champion (1962, 1970, 1973, 1974, 1976, 1978, 1980, 1984, 1990, 1992, 2011, 2013, 2015), runner-up (*1988, 1996, 2018), 3rd place (2017). 1st place in group (1998, 2003). *In 1988, after achieving the runner-up position, Mexico was penalized for using players outside the age limit.

Top scorers in the final round since 2009: José Juan Macías (10), Daniel López (7), Ronaldo Cisneros (6), Hirving Lozano (5), Esteban Lozano (5), Ulises Dávila (4), Alejandro Díaz (4), Salvador Mariscal (4).

Qualified for the final phase as: 3rd Place in the Concacaf U-20 Ranking.

Best position in the FIFA U-20 Men's World Cup: Runner-up (Tunisia 1977), 3rd Place (Colombia 2011).

Footballers to Watch:

Stephano Carrillo: He was the top scorer of the 2023 Concacaf U-17 Championship in Guatemala (8 goals in 6 matches). Additionally, he scored 3 goals in his 4 appearances in the 2023 FIFA U-17 World Cup in Indonesia.

Alexei Domínguez: He was a champion of the 2024 Concacaf Champions Cup with Pachuca, where he participated in 4 matches, scoring a goal in the quarterfinals against CS Herediano of Costa Rica.



Haiti has become a constant participant in the final phase of the Concacaf U-20 Championship since 2013 and in Mexico, will seek to take the next step that leads them to their first FIFA U-20 Men's World Cup.

Haiti achieved an impressive record in the Concacaf qualifiers as the team that scored the most headers with 5 in Group E. Bryan Destin contributed four goals to achieve qualification for the group stage in Mexico.

Last appearance in the final round: Honduras 2022 (round of 16).

Qualified for the final phase as: Winner of Group E in the Concacaf U-20 Championship 2024 Qualifiers.

Appearances in the FIFA U-20 Men's World Cup: 0.

Footballers to Watch:

Bryan Destin: He scored 50% of Haiti's goals in Group E of the qualifiers for the 2024 U-20 Championship (4 out of 8 in 11 shots). He scored 2 goals with headers, 1 from play, and 1 from a penalty kick.

Joseph Belmar: He scored a header in the 1-1 draw against Puerto Rico in Haiti's last game in Group E of the qualifiers for the 2024 U-20 Championship.
