

2024 CONCACAF W Gold Cup

Argentina vs. Dominican Rep / Group A

Dignity Health Sports Park, Carson, CA February 26

Argentina and the Dominican Republic will face each other for the first time in a CONCACAF tournament.

Prior to facing the Dominican Republic, Argentina has played against 10 CONCACAF teams: Mexico, United States, Canada, Costa Rica, Guatemala, El Salvador, Panama, Puerto Rico, Nicaragua, and Trinidad.

The Dominican Republic has previously played 3 matches against CONMEBOL opponents with one victory (3-0 against Bolivia), one draw (1-1 against Bolivia), both in international friendlies in 2021, and one defeat (6-2 against Venezuela) in the Central American and Caribbean Games in Mexico 2014.



Results in the 2024 Gold Cup (0-0 against Mexico and 4-0 against the United States).

They have gone 450 minutes without scoring a goal. Their last goal was in the 2023 Pan American Games in Chile against Bolivia in the group stage, scored by Julieta Cruz (October 25, 2023).

They have gone 5 matches without winning or scoring goals and have only earned one point out of the last 15 matches played (0-0 against Mexico). They won 1 match out of the last 11 (3-0 against Bolivia in Group B of the 2023 Pan American Games in Chile).

Players to watch:

Mariana Larroquette. She came very close to scoring Argentina's first goal in the Gold Cup after her shot hit the post in the loss against the United States.

Laurina Oliveros. She made 8 saves and 12 clearances against the United States. The goalkeeper kept a clean sheet in the debut against Mexico, where she made a crucial save.



Aldana Cometti. She made 5 ball recoveries and 45 passes along with Vanina Preininger (4) in the loss against the United States.

Camila Gómez Ares. She has started in both matches in the Gold Cup and had (2) shots on target against Mexico.

Dominican Republic (DOM)

Results in the 2024 W Cup (5-0 against the United States and 8-0 against Mexico).

They achieved 6 victories in their last 8 matches across all competitions in 2023-2024. Their wins were against Barbados (3-0 and 1-7), Saint Vincent (0-8 and 4-0), Bermuda (2-0), and Guyana (1-0). The 2 defeats were in the group stage of the W Gold Cup.

They achieved a 60% clean sheet rate in their last 10 matches. However, they conceded 13 goals in 2 games in Group A CWGC 2024.

Their last 2 draws were against Puerto Rico in International Friendlies in July 2023 (1-1 and 0-0). From there, they accumulated 6 victories and 3 defeats.

Players to watch:

Kathrynn González. She has had (2) shots in the current tournament. She scored the winning goal 1-0 against Guyana in the Prelims.

Gabriella Cuevas. The defender made 6 ball recoveries, 10 clearances, and 23 passes against Mexico.

Jazmin Jackson. She was the team's top scorer in RTWGC with (4). She has played in both matches of Group A.

Paloma Peña. She made 3 saves and 3 clearances in the defeat against Mexico. She has 8 saves and 5 clearances in the 2024 W Gold Cup.
