

Inter Miami CF (USA) vs. Cavalier FC (JAM)

Chase Stadium (USA)

This will be their first-ever meeting in the Concacaf Champions Cup.



Inter Miami CF defeated Sporting Kansas City in both legs of Round One with a 4-1 aggregate score and will compete in the Round of 16 for the second consecutive time.

With the victory over Kansas City, Inter Miami became the MLS club with the most wins against MLS opponents in the Concacaf Champions Cup with three, surpassing Los Angeles FC with two.

In the 2024 edition, they eliminated Nashville SC with a 5-3 aggregate score, where Lionel Messi and Luis Suárez found the net in both legs of the series.

Inter Miami has won three of its last five matches, securing a 50 percent win rate in the Concacaf Champions Cup across two appearances. The Florida-based club has scored in all six of its previous matches.

Inter Miami has both scored and conceded in each of its home matches, opening the scoring within the first 20 minutes in every game against Nashville SC and CF Monterrey in 2024 and Sporting Kansas City in 2025, while allowing four second-half goals.

A remarkable 91 percent of the club's goals across two Concacaf Champions Cup editions have come from South American players, including Paraguayan Diego Gómez with one, Uruguayan Luis Suárez with three, Argentines Lionel Messi with four, Tadeo Allende with one, and Tomás Avilés with one.

Concacaf Champions Cup appearances in all formats included 2 in 2024 and 2025.

Best result: quarterfinals in 2024.

Concacaf Champions Cup record in all formats included 6 matches played, 3 wins, 1 draw, 2 losses, 11 goals for, and 9 goals against.

Fastest goal in Concacaf Champions Cup 2025: Lionel Messi at 18 minutes and 30 seconds against Sporting Kansas City in Round One, Second Leg.

Players to watch:

Lionel Messi from Argentina. Scored in both matches against Sporting Kansas City with 2 goals and led the series in shots with 5. The global superstar has netted 4 goals and provided 2 assists in 5 Concacaf Champions Cup appearances. He has contributed to every goal scored while on the field, leading the team with 16 total shots.



Luis Suárez from Uruguay. Has played all 6 matches for Inter Miami in the Concacaf Champions Cup. Scored 1 goal, provided 1 assist, and took 3 shots in the 2025 edition. The Uruguayan striker has been directly involved in 55 percent of the team's goals with 3 goals and 3 assists.

Federico Redondo from Argentina. Led the team in ball recoveries with 9 in Round One against Sporting Kansas City. The Argentine midfielder was the only outfield player to play every minute, totaling 190, with a 93 percent passing accuracy.



Cavalier FC qualified directly for the Round of 16 in the 2025 Concacaf Champions Cup as the 2024 Concacaf Caribbean Cup champion. This will be their second consecutive appearance after debuting in the 2024 edition.

The Kingston-based club will be looking to score its first goal in the competition. In their previous tournament appearance, the Jamaican side lost both Round One matches against FC Cincinnati by scores of 2-0 and 4-0.

Cavalier was the runner-up in the 2023 Caribbean Cup and champions in 2024. They finished both editions as the tournament's top-scoring team with 16 goals in 2023 and 20 in 2024 and had the top scorer in each edition, with Shaniel Thomas in 2023 and Shaquille Stein in 2024 with eight goals. Cavalier FC leads the all-time Caribbean Cup standings with 30 points.

Concacaf Champions Cup appearances in all formats included 2 in 2024 and 2025.

Debut in 2024 Round One.

Round of 16 appearances: one in 2025 against Inter Miami.

Players to watch:

Dwayne Atkinson from Jamaica. The most involved player in goals in the 2024 Caribbean Cup, scoring six goals and providing five assists. Atkinson also led the tournament in shots with 23.

Shaquille Stein from Suriname. The top scorer of the 2024 Caribbean Cup with eight goals, helping his team lift the championship trophy. The forward averaged a goal per match and registered 17 shots in 581 minutes played.



Jalmaro Calvin from Jamaica. One of the most influential players in the 2024 Concacaf Caribbean Cup with 11 goal contributions, scoring five goals and providing six assists. Calvin has scored 12 goals in his first 23 matches of the 2024-25 Jamaica Premier League season.
