

Thorns FC (USA) vs. Santa Fe (PAN)

Group B, October 1st, 2024, Providence Park, Portland.

They will face each other for the first time in an international club tournament.



Portland Thorns Football Club has secured 50% of the points (W-1 L-1) after starting with a 3-1 win against América in week 2, followed by a 3-2 loss to San Diego Wave.

Portland Thorns will play their second home match; in their previous home game, they defeated Club América 3-1 (Christine Sinclair x2 and Reilyn Turner; Irene Guerrero).

The three-time NWSL champions scored within the first 30 minutes in both of their matches. Conversely, the 4 goals they conceded were in the second half (2 penalties, 1 header, and 1 from open play).

Record in CWCC 2024/25: GP-2 W-1 D-0 L-1 (5GF-4GA).

Top scorers: Christine Sinclair (CAN) 2, Reilyn Turner (USA) 2, Sophia Smith (USA) 1.

Assists: Olivia Moultrie (USA) 2, Marie Müller (GER), Alexa Spaanstra (USA).

Saves: 9. Goalkeepers: Shelby Hogan (USA) 8, Mackenzie Arnold (AUS) 1.

Opportunities to score (15), shots on goal (4).

Standout players:

Reilyn Turner (USA). She has scored in both matches, and along with Christine Sinclair, they have two goals each in CWCC 2024-25.

Sophia Smith (USA). Scored the first goal in the last match and made 3 shots against San Diego Wave. Smith has played 47 minutes on the field.

Olivia Moultrie (USA). Has 2 assists. The 19-year-old player made 3 shots in her 124 minutes on the field and completed 84% of her passes.



Santa Fe FC will play their last match in their debut tournament in the CWCC 2024-25, where they lost all three matches (2-0 vs. San Diego Wave, 2-1 vs. Vancouver, and 5-0 vs. Club América).

The team scored 1 goal from 18 shots (María Murillo vs. Vancouver Whitecaps). The Panamanian champions conceded 5 goals in their only away match (5-0 vs. Club América).

Santa Fe (14) and Frazsiers (20) are the two teams with the most saves to date in the CWCC 2024-24.

Top scorer: María Murillo (PAN) 1.

Saves: 14. Goalkeepers: Yenith Bailey (PAN) 13, Carolina López (PAN) 1.

Opportunities to score (18), shots on target (7).

Standout players:

María Murillo (PAN). Played in all matches and scored the team's only goal (vs. Vancouver Whitecaps). The defender made 5 clearances and 4 shots.

Yenith Bailey (PAN). The experienced goalkeeper made 9 saves and 3 clearances against Club América. Bailey has made 13 saves in the CWCC 2024-25.

Erika Largo (COL). The midfielder made (5) shots and has a passing accuracy of 84%.
