They will face each other for the first time in the Concacaf Nations League, the last time in an official match was 24 years ago, in the Concacaf qualifiers for the FIFA World Cup Korea and Japan 2002, on Sep 3, 2000, in Port of Spain (TRI), a 4-0 victory for the "Soca Warriors", with goals from Russell Latapy 28', Reynold Carrington 30', Stokely Mason 54', and Angus Eve 90'.

Since that date, they have only met twice in friendly matches, both ending in victory for Canada, on Aug 15, 2012, 2-0 in Fort Lauderdale (USA), with goals from Tosaint Ricketts 58' and Will Johnson penalty 86'; and the most recent friendly on Jun 10, 2019, in Fullerton (USA) behind closed doors, 2-0, with a brace from Scott Arfield; this match served as preparation for the Gold Cup of that same year.

How goals were scored: From open play (3), with a header (1).

Chances to score goals: 23. Shots on target (10).

Players to watch:

Jonathan David: Alongside Alphonso Davies, he is Canada's top scorer (6) in the Concacaf Nations League. Both scored in the CNL 2022/23 semifinal against Panama. David scored a goal in the 2023/24 quarterfinals against Jamaica.

Alphonso Davies: He has made 44 appearances and scored 15 goals for Canada. He scored 1 of the 2 goals in the FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022 and in the CNL 2023/24 quarterfinals against Jamaica. He has scored 6 goals in the CNL.

Milan Borjan: He made 3 saves in the series against Jamaica and was the goalkeeper with the most clearances in the quarterfinals with (9). The World Cup participant in Qatar 2022 has 12 saves in the history of the CNL.

Players to watch:

Reon Moore: He has scored three goals and provided one assist with 10 shots in the CNL 2023-24. Moore scored a goal in the 2-1 victory against the United States in the quarterfinals.

Ryan Telfer: He has (2) assists, scored one goal, took 4 shots, and made 139 passes in six appearances in the CNL.

Denzil Smith: He has made 31 saves in the CNL 2023-24. He was the goalkeeper with the most saves (22) in the League A of the CNL 2023/24 (in the 4 matches of Group A) and kept a clean sheet in his debut against Curaçao.
