

## FC Motagua (HON) vs. CS Herediano (CRC)

Wednesday, September 25, 2024, Estadio Nacional Chelato Uclés, Tegucigalpa.

FC Motagua and CS Herediano will face each other for the second time in the CCAC in less than a month. In their last encounter, they drew 1-1 in Group A on August 28, 2024. For CS Herediano, John Jairo Ruíz scored, and for FC Motagua, Rubilio Castillo scored from a penalty. With the draw, Motagua secured their qualification to the quarterfinals. For Rubilio Castillo, it was his third goal against CS Herediano.

Throughout their history in club tournaments, these two teams have faced each other 5 times, with two wins and one draw each.

The first time was in the 1975 Concacaf Champions Cup where CS Herediano won the series 3-2 on aggregate.

In the first leg in Tegucigalpa (HON) on May 4, 1975, Motagua won 2-1 with goals from Salvador "Pólvora" Bernárdez and Pedro Caetano, and Vicente Wanchope for Herediano; in the return match in Heredia on May 15, 1975, the home team won 2-0 with goals from Fernando "Macho" Montero and Rafael "Zepellín" Camacho.

The second time was in the final of the Scotiabank Concacaf League 2028, where CS Herediano won the title with a 3-2 aggregate score. In the first leg in Heredia (CRC) on October 25, 2018, the home team won 2-0 with goals from Jimmy Marín and Allan Cruz; in the return leg in Tegucigalpa (HON) on November 1, 2018, Motagua won 2-1 with a double from Rubilio Castillo and a goal from Jimmy Marín at the end of the match, which gave Herediano the title.

FC Motagua will play in the quarterfinals for the eighth time, having been eliminated twice. The first was against their arch-rival CD Olimpia in a single match in the Scotiabank Concacaf League 2020, with a 2-0 win for the Leones with goals from Maylor Núñez and Deybi Flores on December 2, 2020.

The second elimination was by Club Atlético Independiente de Panamá with a 3-1 aggregate score. On September 26, 2023, in Tegucigalpa (HON), they drew 1-1, with Agustín Auzmendi scoring for Motagua and Héctor Hurtado for the Panamanians; in the return game in Panama City (PAN) on October 3, 2023, CAI won 2-0 with a double from Carlos Small.

CS Herediano (CRC) will play for a spot in the semifinals of an official international tournament for the 7th time in its history, having been eliminated three times and advanced three times previously. The most recent was against Comunicaciones FC (GUA) in the 2023 Central American Cup, advancing with a 3-2 aggregate, with all goals scored in the return game on

October 4, 2023, in Cartago (CRC). The local goals were scored by Ángel Sayago x2 and Fernán Faerron, while José Corena and Erik González scored for the visitors.

The last elimination of the "Tico" club in the quarterfinals was in the 2024 Concacaf Champions Cup when they faced the eventual champion CF Pachuca (MEX). In the first leg in San José (CRC) on April 3, 2024, they lost 0-5 with goals for the Tuzos scored by Salomón Rondón x3, Alexéi Domínguez, and Alán Bautista; in the return game on April 10, 2024, in Pachuca (MEX) they won 2-1 with goals by Bryan "Cotorro" González and Salomón Rondón, and Everardo Rubio scored a penalty for the "Ticos."

Fútbol Club Motagua achieved 5 victories in 12 matches in the CCAC. They were unable to secure a win in the quarterfinals (D-1 L-1) against CAI in 2023.

The Blue Eagles are undefeated in 3 matches (W-2 D-1). Moreover, they have never lost playing at home, boasting 4 wins and 2 draws. They scored goals in each of their 6 home matches in the CCAC.

The Cyclone won 2 of their last 9 CCAC matches, both in Group A of the 2024 edition (3-2 vs. San Francisco and 4-1 vs. Tauro FC).

They faced 3 Costa Rican teams, achieving 2 draws and 2 losses between 2023 and 2024 (against Alajuelense, Saprissa, and Herediano).

Participations in the CCAC: 2 (2023 and 2024).

Best result in the CCAC: Quarterfinals 2023 and 2024.

## Players to watch:

**Agustín Auzmendi (ARG)**. Is the top scorer in the CCAC with 9 goals in 12 matches. In the group stage of the 2024 edition, he made 8 shots. In total, he has taken 33 shots in the CCAC and scored 1 goal in the quarterfinals (2023 vs. CAI).

**Román Castillo (HON)**. The team captain is the leader in shots (11) in the 2024 edition with two goals scored (vs. Tauro FC and Herediano). In Concacaf club tournaments, he has scored 7 goals in 19 appearances.

**Yeison Mejía (HON)**. Had a shooting accuracy of 40% in the group stage. He scored 2 goals (a double against Tauro FC) on 5 shots. Mejía has scored 5 goals in 12 appearances in the Central American Cup.



Club Sport Herediano remains undefeated in the 2024 CCAC (W-3 D-1), having scored all 4 of their goals in the second half. The team secured 3 victories in the 2024 edition, with all goals coming in the second half (1-0 against Tauro, 1-0 against Diriangén, and 0-1 against San Francisco).

CS Herediano has been unbeaten across the two editions of the CCAC, with 7 wins and 5 draws, including five clean sheets. In the quarterfinals of 2023, they eliminated Comunicaciones FC from Guatemala with a 3-2 scoreline.

## Players to watch:

**John Jairo Ruiz (CRC)**. Scored the tying goal 1-1 against Motagua in the group stage of the 2024 edition. He has scored two goals in his 4 matches and has played in 9 CCAC matches.

**Elías Aguilar (CRC)**. Provided two assists in the group stage, made five shots in 4 appearances, and completed 133 passes. He has played in 37 matches in Concacaf club tournaments, scoring three goals and providing five assists.

**Marcel Hernández (CUB)**. Has played 19 matches in Concacaf club tournaments. In the CCAC, he has scored 4 goals in 11 appearances, two of which were penalties in 2023 while playing for CS Cartaginés. In the 2023 edition, he scored a goal in the quarterfinals against LD Alajuelense.
