

Mexico vs. Panama

SoFi Stadium

This will be the 5th meeting between these two teams in the Concacaf Nations League, with Mexico winning all four previous encounters.

October 15, 2019 – MEX 3x1 PAN, Group B (Roberto Alvarado 28', José Juan Macías 75', Rodolfo Pizarro 90+2' / Carlos Salcedo own goal 42').

November 15, 2019 – PAN 0-3 MEX, Group B (Raúl Jiménez 8', penalty 85', Édson Álvarez 70').

June 18, 2023 - PAN 0-1 MEX, Third Place (Jesús Gallardo 4').

March 21, 2024 – PAN 0-3 MEX, Semifinal (Édson Álvarez 40', Julián Quiñones 43', Orbelín Pineda 67').

This will be their second final in a Concacaf-organized tournament, the first being the 2023 Gold Cup final at SoFi Stadium in Los Angeles, where Mexico claimed a 1-0 victory thanks to Santiago Giménez's 88th-minute goal, securing its 12th Gold Cup title.

Panama is the Central American team with the most final appearances in Concacaf tournaments, having played three Gold Cup finals (2005, 2013, 2023). Now, it will become the first Central American team to contest the Nations League final. Meanwhile, for Mexico, this will be their 17th final, of which 15 were in the Gold Cup (12 titles, 3 runner-up finishes) and 2 in the Nations League (2 runner-up finishes).

Mexico holds a 15-match unbeaten streak against Panama in all competitions (13W-2D), their longest streak without defeat in this rivalry. Panama's only two victories over Mexico came just before this streak began, both in the 2013 Gold Cup:

- Group Stage (July 7, 2013) MEX 1-2 PAN (Marco Fabián 45' / Gabriel Torres penalty 7', 48').
- Semifinal (July 24, 2013) MEX 1-2 PAN (Luis Montes 25' / Blas Pérez 12', Román Torres 60').

Before those two Panamanian wins, Mexico had a 13-game unbeaten streak against Panama (9W-4D) from 1938 to 2013.

Players to watch:

Raúl Jiménez (MEX) scored Mexico's fastest-ever goal in the CNL (00m47s), which is also the 4th fastest in tournament history. With his brace, he reached 5 goals in CNL, leading the all-time Mexican scorers in Nations League history. His double was the 122nd in the history of the tournament across all teams. Mexico moved into 6th place in most braces scored (4), joining Guatemala, Bahamas, Turks & Caicos, and the Dominican Republic. Jiménez now has 37 international goals, ranking 4th in Mexico's all-time scoring list, just 2 goals away from surpassing Cuauhtémoc Blanco (38) and entering the historical Top 3.

Santiago Giménez. Scored the goal that gave Mexico the **2023 Gold Cup title** in the final against Panama (1-0). The forward is set to reach **10 CNL appearances (1 assist).**

Edson Álvarez. The captain recorded 3 ball recoveries, 5 clearances, and completed 89% of his passes against Canada in the semifinals. He leads Mexico in total passes (232) in the competition. Scored 3 goals in 13 CNL appearances (2 vs. Panama in the 2019/20 Group B stage and 2023/24 semifinals).

Julián Quiñones. Scored against Panama in the 2023/24 Nations League semifinal (3-0). He has 2 appearances in the current edition and 1 shot on target.

Johan Vásquez. A key defensive figure for Mexico in the semifinal against Canada. The Genoa (ITA) player had **2 shots**, **3 recoveries**, **5 clearances**, **and 26 completed passes** against Les Rouges.

With a 1-0 win over the United States, Panama snapped a 5-game losing streak against North American teams in CNL. It was just the second time they have scored against these teams and the first time they have kept a clean sheet. This marked Panama's 4th victory in 29 all-time meetings against the U.S., and only their second 1-0 win, the previous one coming in the FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022 qualifiers, at Estadio Rommel Fernández on October 10, 2021 (Aníbal Godoy 54').

Players to watch:

Cecilio Waterman (PAN) scored his 4th CNL goal, his first in a semifinal, and his second in a direct elimination match (2023 quarterfinals vs. Costa Rica). His goal against the U.S. was his first-ever goal against them in all competitions, and it became the latest goal ever scored by Panama in CNL history (92m57s), surpassing Édgar Bárcenas' goal against Martinique on June 9, 2022 (92m46s). Waterman is now tied with Bárcenas for second place in Panama's all-time CNL scorers list (4 goals each).

Adalberto Carrasquilla. Provided the assist for Waterman's goal and completed 87% of his passes in the semifinals. The 2023 Gold Cup Golden Ball winner has scored 2 goals and delivered 4 assists in Nations League history. Carrasquilla has reached 20 CNL appearances, making him Panama's all-time leader in matches played in the competition.

Aníbal Godoy. The current captain has faced Mexico 15 times in his career across multiple tournaments: Gold Cup (4 matches), Concacaf Qualifiers (5 matches), Concacaf Nations League (3 matches), and friendlies (3 matches).

José Fajardo. Panama's all-time top scorer in Nations League history (5 goals in 14 appearances). He registered 4 shots and scored against Costa Rica in this edition. He has played in all four CNL editions and scored in the last three.

Orlando Mosquera. Made 5 saves in the current tournament and kept a clean sheet in 2 of 3 matches. He has 32 career CNL saves. With the win over the U.S., he recorded 6 career CNL clean sheets, tying him for second place among goalkeepers with the most shutouts in CNL history, alongside Kishmar Primus (BRB), Eloy Room (CUW), Milan Borjan (CAN), and Charles Tillett (BLZ).
