## **Cibao FC (DOM) vs. Cavalier FC (JAM)**

Stadium Cibao FC, Santiago de los Caballeros, DOM

### **Post-Match Data Cavalier FC 1 Cibao FC 0**

Shaquille Stein from Cavalier FC became the first footballer born in Suriname to score a goal in a final for a Jamaican club. He also reached eight goals in the CCC, all with Cavalier FC.

Cavalier FC extended their unbeaten streak in the CCC to four consecutive matches (W-3 D-1). Playing at home, they achieved for the second time in their history two consecutive games without conceding goals. The last time was in 2023 when they kept a clean sheet against Moca FC (DOM) 3-0 on Matchday 3 of Group A and against Harbour View (JAM) 0-0 in the first leg of the semifinals that year.

This marked the fifth undefeated game for Cavalier FC against Dominican Republic clubs in CCC history (W-3 D-2). Additionally, they have a streak of four consecutive matches without conceding against Dominican opponents.

With the loss to Cavalier FC, Cibao FC broke a streak of seven consecutive matches without a loss in the CCC (W-6 D-1). At the same time, it ended their best winning streak, which stood at five victories.

For Cibao FC, this was their third defeat in 23 CCC matches. Jamaican rivals are the ones who have defeated them the most (2), with one loss also coming against a team from Suriname.

Cibao FC is playing a two-legged final for the first time in their history. Their previous two finals were single-match events: in 2017, they were champions against San Juan Jabloteh (TRI), and in 2022, they lost to Violette AC (HAI).

Cibao FC is the first Dominican Republic club to lose a game in a Final in the history of Caribbean club tournaments. In 2017, the same Cibao FC won against San Juan Jabloteh (TRI). In 2018, Atlético Pantoja drew but became champions against Arnett Gardens (JAM) by winning on penalties. In 2022, Cibao FC drew and lost the title on penalties to Violette AC (HAI).

### **All-Time Series**

They will meet for the third time in history. Cavalier FC remains undefeated against Cibao FC, with one win and one draw.

Cavalier defeated Cibao FC 1-0 in the first leg of the 2024 Concacaf Caribbean Cup Final at the National Stadium in Kingston.

Previously, they drew 3-3 in an exciting first encounter in the historical series during Group A of the 2022 CFU Club Championship (the twenty-fourth and final edition of the tournament), along with Violette (HAI).

## **CIBAO FC (DOM)**

Cibao Fútbol Club aims to overturn the 1-0 deficit from the first leg against Cavalier FC.

The team, led by Haitian coach **Scheldeur Sainvilus**, lost their unbeaten streak in the CCC 2024. Prior to the first leg of the final against Cavalier, the Dominican team had achieved five consecutive victories (2-1 vs. Grenades FC, 3-2 vs. AC Port of Spain, 4-1 vs. Ouanaminthe, and 3-2 vs. Real Hope).

In their second participation in the CCC 2024, Cibao FC remains unbeaten at home with three wins and two draws.

**The Orange Beast** is the team with the most shots (99) in the current edition of the CCC, of which (45 shots were on target, 39 off-target, 2 hit the posts, and 13 were goals). Cibao FC also has the best passing accuracy (86%). Along with Cavalier FC, they are the clubs with the highest number of points (16) and victories (5).

**Appearances in the Concacaf Caribbean Cup:** 2 (2023 and 2024).

**Best result in the CCC:** Finalist (2024).

#### **Players to watch:**

**Rivaldo Correa (COL):** He was the player with the most attempts in the first leg of the final (7). The Colombian leads the 2024 edition in shots (23) and is the team's top scorer (5). He scored 2 goals in the semifinals against Real Hope.

**José Barreto (URU):** He was the leader in accurate passes (154) in the first leg of the final at the National Stadium in Kingston. The Uruguayan has 5 appearances in the CCC and a passing accuracy of 92%.

**Jean López (DOM):** He scored 3 goals and provided 2 assists in the 2024 CCC. He is the leader in passes for the Dominican team (366) with an accuracy rate of 93%. He scored in victories against Grenades FC, AC Port of Spain, and Real Hope.

**Eddipo Rodríguez (DOM):** He was the second player with the most attempts against Cavalier (5). The forward scored 2 goals in 7 appearances in the current edition of the CCC 2024 (scoring in the group stage against Grenades and Ouanaminthe).



## CAVALIER FC (JAM)

With the advantage of a 1-0 victory in the first leg, Cavalier Football Club will seek to lift the trophy for the first time in their history in their second attempt. In 2023, they fell to Robinhood in the decisive matches.

Cavalier FC has lost only 1 of their 7 away matches in the CCC: a 1-0 defeat in the 2023 final against SV Robinhood of Suriname.

In the 2023 edition, despite not winning the title, Cavalier FC was the team that scored the most goals (16), and currently, they hold the record for most goals scored across two editions with 36. In 2024, their offensive power remains intact with 19 goals, 12 assists, and defensively, no team has recovered more balls than Cavalier FC with 90. Of the 19 goals scored, three were penalties.

The Jamaican Premier League team has won 5 of their 7 matches in the current edition of the CCC (0-2 vs. Mt. Pleasant, 4-1 vs. Police FC, 1-4 vs. Arnett Gardens, 7-0 vs. Moca FC, and 1-0 vs. Cibao FC).

Cavalier FC has not conceded goals in the first half of 3 CCC finals matches (2023 and 2024).

**Appearances in the Concacaf Caribbean Cup:** 2 (2023 and 2024).

**Best result:** Runner-up (2023) and finalist (2023 and 2024).

**Record in the CCC:** GP-15 W-9 D-3 L-3 (GF-35 GA-11).

**Biggest win:** 7-0 vs. Moca FC (Kaile Auvray x2, Shaquille Stein x3, Christopher Ainsworth, and Dwayne Atkinson), semifinals second leg - National Stadium, Kingston (30-OCT-2024).

**Record in CCC 2024:** GP-7 W-4 D-1 L-1 (GF-19 GA-4).

**Top scorers:** Shaquille Stein (SUR) 8, Dwayne Atkinson (JAM) 5, Jalmaro Calvin (JAM) 2, Christopher Ainsworth (JAM) 2, Kaile Auvray (FRA) 2.

**Youngest scorer in the CCC:** Christopher Ainsworth (JAM) vs. AC Port of Spain (Group A - Round 2 - CCC 2023) - 18 years.

**Oldest scorer in the CCC:** Marvin Bellance (FRA) vs. Golden Lion (Group A - Round 5 - CCC 2023) - 24 years, 323 days.

**Fastest goal in the CCC:** Kaile Auvray (FRA) vs. Moca FC (Semifinals second leg - CCC 2024) - 0 min 41 sec.

#### **Players to watch:**

**Shaquille Stein (SUR):** Scored the winning goal in the 1-0 victory against Cibao FC in the first leg of the final. The forward leads the tournament in goals (8) in this edition, scoring 4 goals in his last 2 matches.

**Dwayne Atkinson (JAM):** Provided the assist for Shaquille Stein's goal. He has taken 12 shots in this edition. Atkinson has been involved in 10 of the last 16 goals (5 goals and 5 assists) and leads the 2024 edition in assists with 5.

**Jalmaro Calvin (JAM):** Took three shots in the first match against Cibao FC. To date, he has 17 shots. The 21-year-old forward has scored 2 goals and 3 assists in 7 appearances in CCC 2024.

**Vino Barclett (LCA):** A standout performer for Cavalier FC in the first leg of the final against Cibao FC with 8 saves and 7 clearances. He has played in 12 matches, conceded 8 goals, and kept 6 clean sheets, 5 of them in the final stages of the tournament.
